His section on the sacrament of penance in church history lays out a comprehensive overview of the development in the sacrament of penance from the patristic period to the period immediately before Vatican II. At the heart of the new evangelization is the proclamation of Christ who has come into the world to reconcile sinful human beings with the transcendent love of God. For those living today in a post-Christian world, the powerful message of God's merciful love expressed through the sacrament of reconciliation is a most valuable way of knowing the joy of the Gospel.
